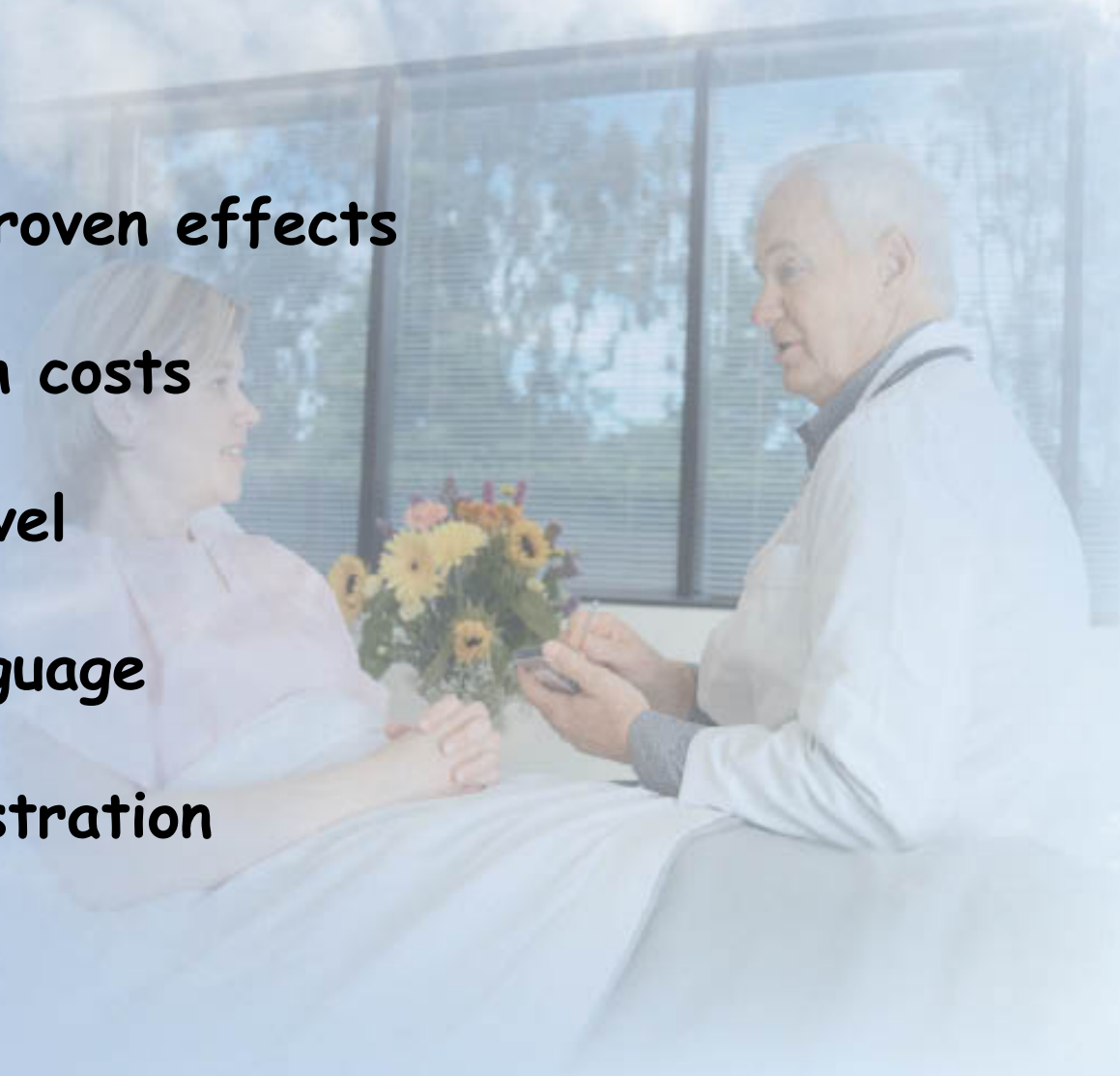


Good:
